



LUMINARIA NIGHT - KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for participating in Luminaria Night 2023. This year's event will take place on **Saturday, December 9th**.

Please have the luminaria placed and lit by 5pm. To assemble and display the kits:

1. Put about 1 cup of sand in the bottom of each paper bag. Place the candle in the center of the sand.
2. For a more stable luminaria, we suggest that you fold down the top of the bag into a cuff.

When assembling luminaria, please keep in mind the following regarding City of Bethlehem regulations:

The bags must be placed at least 3 feet away from each other and anything combustible (including homes or buildings, etc.). In addition, the bags must maintain a 5-foot clear pedestrian walkway at all times, they may not be placed on the curb where there is parking allowed, they cannot be placed anywhere that may cause a tripping hazard, and only the property owner (or his/her designee) may purchase, set up, and remove items placed within the property lines.

Please go green and save your sand to reuse in 2024.
