40 Years of Serving Our Neighbors!

On our 40th anniversary at New Bethany, Inc. (formerly New Bethany Ministries), we should take a moment to reflect on our foundation. The town "Bethany" has biblical roots, the home of Lazarus where Jesus found friendship, food, and shelter. And so in 1985 when the Episcopal Church formed a service ministry, they titled it "a new Bethany" on the Southside of Bethlehem. New Bethany Ministries was dedicated under a subsidiary of the Episcopal Diocese of Bethlehem and housed their first family on the corner of Wyandotte and W. 4th Street in December of that year.

Forty years and 1.1 million meals served later, New Bethany is in many ways the same today as it was in 1985: a place to find friendship, food and shelter for all who seek help. In just as many ways, local community needs have guided change and growth. Some initiatives have closed: Habitat House (now our Main Office), the Used Furniture Store and Restoration House remain an important part of our history.

Other programs, like Wyandotte Apartments, Columbia House in Coplay and Representative Payee, are critical to our work today. Brand new programs, like Housing Assistance provide housing search and rental help or our remodeled Choice Food Pantry as a free grocery store for all, reflect new and growing needs in Bethlehem and the Lehigh Valley.

As New Bethany celebrates our 40th anniversary, we reflect on the thousands of lives changed through our programs and services. We see over 100 neighbors visit our Drop-In Center daily for a hot lunch. We



of unhoused children and youth every month, whose families seek a stable place to call home. And in the aftermath of the Covid pandemic, we assisted thousands of households facing eviction and work to find them the help to keep them afloat.
